SPORTS EVENT 2023-24 FROM DISTRICT LEVEL TO PROVINCIAL LEVEL**

The first principle of progress and success for athletes in educational institutions is that the institution's sports grounds and gymnasiums must bustle with athletes. Alongside this, it's also essential to introduce them to modern scientific principles in sports through innovative research. You'll be pleased to know that the Sports Wing of DPI Colleges Punjab, under the leadership of Dr. Syed Ansar Azhar, organized the 2<sup>nd</sup> Higher Education Department Punjab Sports Event 2023-24 from the district level to the Punjab level.

**Statistics of these events:**

**Inter-Collegiate Championships at District Level (Phase I):**

Championships for boys and girls were held in 946 venues across 825 colleges in 36 districts of Punjab, with nearly 126,000 students participating. Approximately 14,500 students qualified for the second phase, setting a unique record in Pakistan's educational institutions.

**Inter-District Championships at Division Level (Phase II):**

In the second phase, approximately 14,500 players participated, and events were held in 256 venues in 36 districts and 9 divisions of Punjab, with 3,510 students qualifying for the third phase.

**Inter-Divisional Championships at Punjab Level (Final Phase):**

In the third and final phase, 3,510 players participated. Competitions were held in 28 venues in Faisalabad, Multan, and Lahore, where 390 student-athletes secured victory.

### **Opening Ceremonies held in Faisalabad, Multan, and Lahore:**

The special aspect of the 2nd Higher Education Department Punjab Inter-Collegiate Sports Events 2023-24 was the inauguration ceremonies held in three districts of Punjab. Students from all divisions, clad in track suits of vibrant colors, filled the fields adorned with tents, banners, and flags, reflecting the spirit of sportsmanship.

### **Closing Ceremony held in Lahore:**

The concluding ceremony of the 2nd Higher Education Department Punjab Inter-Collegiate Sports Events 2023-24 was organized under the supervision of Sports Wing DPI Colleges Punjab at Government Graduate MAO College Lahore. Dr. Syed Anser Azhar, Additional DPI Colleges Punjab, Mr. Ahsan Mukhtar, Consultant Sports HED, Mohammad Anees Sheikh, Secretary Lahore Board, Dr. Bushra Bibi, Principals from educational institutions, and other dignitaries were present. The formal ceremony commenced with the recitation of the Holy Quran, followed by Naat and the National Anthem. Students, adorned in colorful attire, received cash prizes, medals, and trophies, acknowledging their hard work. Lahore Division secured 27 gold medals, leading Punjab. Faisalabad Division stood second with 24 gold medals, followed by Sahiwal Division with 17 gold medals and Sargodha Division with 15 gold medals.

In this event, athletes were awarded a total cash prize of 10.85 million rupees by the Higher Education Department Punjab as a token of appreciation for their efforts. Professor Ijaz, Research Officer Lahore Board, through his inspiring words and beautiful poetry, uplifted the spirits of the audience, including conscientious teachers and enthusiastic students.

### **Thanks to Faisalabad, Multan, Lahore Division Organizing Committees:**



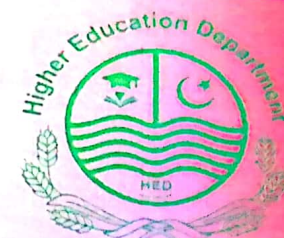
